

# DEVONSHIRE POINTE HALLOWEEN 2020

It has been a crazy year so let's enjoy Halloween in a safe way!

If you choose to participate this year, we strongly encourage our residents to follow the guidelines below issued by the St. Joseph County Health Department.

- Anyone who is positive for COVID-19 or who has been identified as a close contact should not participate in in-person trick or treating or other Halloween activities.
- Anyone who is not feeling well should also stay home and not participate in activities with other people.
- Trick-or-treat with only members of your own household.
- Wear a face covering that is not a costume mask. Face coverings should fit snugly over the mouth and nose.
- Trick or treaters should avoid yelling and shouting "trick or treat" as yelling increases the spread of droplets.
- Individuals handing out candy should wear face mask and wash or sanitize hands frequently.
- Trick or treaters should not grab candy out of a common bowl. Individual treats should be offered on a tray or table, without contact between the host and trick or treaters.

Further, Devonshire Pointe strongly discourages ringing doorbells and instead encourages outdoor participation from a safe distance.

The Health Department also shared creative ideas on how to distribute treats in a safe and distanced manner.
